

Growing in Grace Co-op at Southview Community Church

We hereby agree to comply with the following rules for the 2011-2012 session of Growing in Grace Co-op at Southview Community Church (SCC):

Be on time. Parents and students agree to be on time for classes. Parents and students should be in the quad area by 8:50am.

Exhibit appropriate behavior/attitudes: proper respect for authority; good manners; indoor voices; loving, kind and patient attitudes towards others. As brothers and sisters in Christ, we desire to affirm and encourage each other. This includes being respectful of the SCC property.

Attire: modesty is our policy, for both boys and girls. NO mini-skirts, short shorts, graphic tees or tight t-shirts. No mid-drift or cleavage showing.

Phone calls & personal property: NO rollershoes, CD players, GAME Boys, Ipods, trading cards, toys or cell phones are allowed. These items will be confiscated on the first offense and returned only to the parent.

If students are on church property, they are required to be in class. No student is to be left unsupervised at any time. Parents agree to accompany students in and out of the building. NO student will be allowed outside without a parent and dropping off at the curb is not allowed for safety reasons.

Discipline by teachers during class will be as follows:

- *Students* will be given two warnings during a class period for inappropriate behavior. If the student continues to act out, he/she will be required to leave the class for the day, and parents will be notified. If inappropriate behavior continues, student will be asked to leave the class for the rest of the session. No refund will be given.
- *Teachers* will arbitrate conflicts/offenses between children to help them reconcile differences following the Biblical pattern of confession, repentance, forgiveness, and reconciliation. (Mt. 18:15; Gal. 6:1; Eph. 4:15; Rom. 15:14). Parents may be notified.

Homework: Students who enroll in classes with homework agree to complete required work. It is the student's responsibility to contact the teacher for assignment when absent from class.

Parents who are dissatisfied with some aspect of SCC Co-op should speak to the appropriate person – teacher or Co-op leaders. If a parent or child has been hurt or offended by a Co-op member, we ask that person take responsibility to go to them in the spirit of peace and speak the truth in love, seeking reconciliation.

By signing this agreement, parents agree that they have carefully considered the classes being offered and understand that all fees must be paid by the due date. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN. Parents must also sign a Statement of Faith which acknowledges that you are a Christian and that classes should be taught from a Christian point of view, when appropriate.

By signing this agreement, parents agree they have reviewed and are committed to adhere to the yearly calendar by attending co-op when classes are scheduled. It does not show proper respect to the teachers, assistants and other

parents, who have spent time preparing lessons, for a member to miss co-op for reasons other than illness, death in the family, religious and/or emergency situations. Eight Monday holidays have been scheduled, please plan your leave accordingly.

Volunteer duties: Parents agree to teach and/or assist other teachers during each class session. This is an “all parents must volunteer” co-op and parents must be present during the co-op.

Parents agree to assume all risks, hazards, and costs incidental to participation at SCC Co-op, and agree to release and hold harmless the teachers, assistants, parents helpers, Co-op leaders, and SCC for any accident, injury, or loss suffered during SCC Co-op.
